

Genetic Carrier Screen Compatibility Match Request

Each person requesting a genetic carrier screen compatibility match with their own carrier screen results (or their egg source's results) must complete the following steps:

Step 1: If you are a new client, please sign up for a Fairfax Cryobank account at <https://fairfaxcryobank.com/search/signup.aspx>.

Step 2: Please confirm the availability and compliance status of your donor(s). Compliance requirements apply specifically to Clients shipping to Colorado or outside the United States. If you have any questions about this step, please contact **Client Services at 800-338-8407**.

Step 3: Complete this document in full and email it and your own (or your egg source's) complete genetic carrier screen results to genetics@fairfaxcryobank.com.

- A. **Scope of Service.** A genetic carrier screen compatibility match is a comparison of the egg source's and sperm donor's genetic carrier screening results and assessment of risk based on each person's report.
- B. **Requirements.** A copy of the egg source's **complete** genetic carrier screen result is required for comparison, regardless of whether the egg source is yourself or an egg donor.
- The egg source's genetic carrier screening must have been performed by a diagnostic laboratory. Fairfax Cryobank will not complete genetic carrier screen compatibility matches when the egg source was tested at a direct-to-consumer testing company or research facility. Examples of this include but are not limited to 23andme.com, sequencing.com, and circledna.com.
 - All genetic carrier screening results must be in English. If the Client provides a translated copy, errors, omissions, or inaccuracies in the translation may result in an incomplete or inaccurate compatibility match. Fairfax Cryobank is not liable for completing a compatibility match based on a mistranslation or other inaccuracy of the translated results.
 - For an egg source who had carrier screening with whole exome sequencing (WES) or whole genome sequencing (WGS), we may not be able to complete a comprehensive genetic carrier screen compatibility

match. Whether or not this is possible will be determined by the Fairfax Cryobank Genetics Team's sole discretion.

- C. **Limitations of Service.** The genetic carrier screen compatibility match considers only the carrier screening results of the egg source provided by the client and the carrier screening results of the sperm donor that are available at the time of the match. No other factors or information, including but not limited to other genetic test results, family or personal medical history, or ancestry, will be considered.

This service reflects the results and scientific understanding available when performed and Fairfax Cryobank will not re-perform, update, or supplement a completed genetic carrier screen compatibility match. The genetic carrier screen compatibility match is intended for informational purposes only and is not medical advice and does not substitute for consultation with the client's own physician or genetic counselor. All donor-selection decisions remain solely the client's responsibility. This service is provided "as is." Fairfax Cryobank disclaims all warranties, express or implied, including merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose. A match does not guarantee that a pregnancy will occur or that any resulting child will be unaffected by any genetic condition or birth defect, whether or not screened.

- D. **Limitations of Carrier Screening.** Screening panels differ in the genes, variants, and methods used, and the genetic carrier screen compatibility match can evaluate only conditions reported on both parties' screening; conditions not screened for cannot be assessed. No carrier screening detects all carriers or variants, so a negative result reduces but does not eliminate the chance that an individual is a carrier and a genetic carrier screen compatibility match showing a reduced risk does not establish that a resulting child will be unaffected.

Maximum Number of Matches Available. The maximum number of donors a client can request a genetic carrier screen compatibility match for is **three**, regardless of whether the requests are made together or at multiple times.
